# **Objective**

**Young Leadership Collaborative (YLC)** was designed to increase the number of youth who can develop their own economic capacities to succeed through personal finance and exploration into the world of entrepreneurship. We wish to develop a continuous reservoir of prospective young entrepreneurs and provide scholarships and equip future business and community leaders.

The Collaborative is structured to provide participants the theoretical and practical tools necessary to manage and build their personal financial portfolios to be successful in business.

# **Schedule**

Eight (8) three hour sessions are conducted that will take place 9am-12pm approximately "two" Saturday's per month, beginning January 11, 2020 and ending April 18, 2020. Additional dates will be determined and may be added for presentation preparation.

### **Design**

The sessions will include instruction, self-assessment, individual and group exercises, lectures, homework, field trips and videos.

# **Materials**

Workbooks are distributed at the beginning of the training and trainers disseminate a variety of materials at each session (exercises, reference materials, etc.)

# Costs
